2019 Greenville Honors Its Own Award Criteria

AWARD CATEGORY

CRITERIA

Artist

This award is given to an artist with Greenville/Washington County roots who has achieved recognition outside the Delta for his or her work. The nominee need not currently reside in Greenville or Washington County.

Bert Miller Volunteer

This award is given to the volunteer who has given time and energy to support the arts in Greenville/Washington County for little or no compensation.

Arts in Education

This award is given to an educator who has enriched the lives of many with his or her support and enthusiasm for teaching and love and knowledge of the arts.

Business

This award is given to the business that has displayed dedication to supporting the arts in Greenville/Washington County through monetary and/or in-kind donations and/or through the commitment of their leadership and employees.

Special Achievement

This award is given to a person, organization or group of individuals who have contributed greatly to the cultural vitality of Greenville/Washington County.

Sandra Lane Service Award

In memory of Sandra Lane, whose outstanding dedication to the work and mission of the Arts Council will never be forgotten. This award is given to an individual who has made an exceptional contribution to the Arts Council's mission through his or her service. The inaugural service award was given in 2017.

Georgie Fisher Lifetime Achievement Award

This award is given when the committee feels that such recognition is warranted by the recipient's lifelong achievement in the arts throughout their professional career. This individual is an artist that has devoted their life to the arts. They no longer need to reside in Greenville/Washington County.
